We will travel to Africa in early March. Harvest of summer crops will be underway and preparation for winter cropping getting into full swing.

It is also considered a prime time for wildlife viewing. It's the end of the rainy season in Tanzania and Zambia when the bush is at its most beautiful and lush. The wildebeest are calving on the Serengeti, the big cats such as lions and leopards are often seen on roads and other spots away from the wet grass and Victoria Falls are at their thunderous peak.
